

# Texas Chapter Professional Manager of the Year Award Public Right-of-Way

# Purpose

The Professional Manager of the Year Award in the Public Right-of-Way category seeks to inspire excellence and dedication by recognizing the outstanding career service achievements of public right-of-way management professionals. The primary focus of this award is the recognition of management demonstrating that all stakeholders share the public right-of-way in harmony and preserve it in the best interest and benefit of the public.

# Eligibility

Any APWA member whose primary responsibility is in right-of-way management is eligible. Members of the TPWA Board of Directors are not eligible during the time they serve on the Board. TPWA Utilities and Public Right-of-Way Committee members are not eligible during the time they serve on the Committee.

Career Length Candidates with a minimum of 10 years qualifying experience may be nominated.

**Agency** Candidates may be employed by either the public or private sector. However, their career service must be in Public Right-of-Way management.

Scope Candidates must manage and have made significant contributions to the advancement of Public Right-of-Way.

#### Selection

The Award winner is selected by the Awards Committee.

### Criteria

The criteria used in the selection process include:

**Profession** Significant contributions to the advancement of public right-of-way management.

**Leadership** Outstanding leadership and vision evidenced by employing progressive management techniques in the area of public right-of-way management.

**Innovation** Employment of new and innovative ideas and technology resulting in the advancement of the effectiveness of public right-of-way management.

Agency Service Implementation of effective methods to optimize fiscal management of public right-of-way operations.

Customer Services Maintenance of a high degree of satisfaction among customers and other stakeholders.

**Community Service** Promotion of the field of public right-of-way management in the community, agency or customers served.

# **Nomination Process**

Any governmental entity, group, or individual may nominate candidates. Nominations are particularly encouraged from Texas Chapter branches. Self-nominations are not accepted. APWA membership is required. Submittals should include nomination form and supporting documentation that clearly addresses the eligibility requirements and the candidate's professional work.

#### Presentation

The award winner(s) are recognized at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Public Works Conference.
