MAINTENANCE WORKER

- High school diploma or GED certificate PLUS 3 months related experience and/or training.
- Valid Texas Driver's License.

SENIOR MAINTENANCE WORKER

- High school diploma or GED certificate PLUS 1 year related experience and/or training.
- Valid Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License.

REQUIREMENTS

Candidates will continue to advance if successful completion of each requirement:

3. Medical Examination (drug screen/physical)

MAINTENANCE WORKER

- Obtain a Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License within 8 months of hire.
- Obtain a TCEQ Class I Wastewater Collection License, TCEQ Class D Water License, and Work Zone Traffic Control certification within one year of hire.

SENIOR MAINTENANCE WORKER

- Obtain a TCEQ Class C Water Distribution License, and TCEQ Class II Wastewater Collection License within one year of hire.
